SUMMARY

- Plan and participate in the work of skilled plumbers engaged in the installation, maintenance, inspection and repair of hot and cold water, heating, gas, air, sewage and drainage systems.
- Oversee the installation, inspection, and repair of related fittings, accessories and appliances.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other related duties may be assigned.

- Cut, blend, thread, assemble, wipe and solder various pipes, fittings, joints, valves, cocks, etc. in connection with installing, altering, replacing and repairing plumbing systems.
- Analyze and interpret blueprints and sketches and obtain required materials, supplies and equipment from stock and issue same to skilled plumbers.
- Locate, when necessary, various sources of trouble from primary and secondary indications and take necessary steps to correct such trouble.
- Responsible for the plumbing maintenance of lavatory facilities, faucets, drinking fountains and sprinkler systems.
- Submit written requests for supplies and equipment, including the determination of kind, size, quantity, and quality.

- Records in daily log requests for service work performed and time and materials expanded.
- Responds to emergencies as needed, including snow removal.

QUALIFICATIONS to perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily.

- Knowledge of plumbing duties in connection with cafeteria equipment, such as steam tables, steam cookers, scullery units and dishwashing machines.
- A thorough knowledge of plumbing installation, maintenance, and repair operations.
- A thorough knowledge of appropriate safety measures.
- The ability to analyze and work from blueprints, working drawings, and sketches.
- The ability to lay out the work of skilled technicians.
- Skills in assembling and connecting fixtures and appliances used in plumbing systems.
- The ability to make written reports and related capacities and abilities.
